My dear M Merrill

I have your letter of 10 and am very glad that you have so greatly improved the Lilienthal & Hargrave surfaces. I shall be pleased to receive the blue print which you mention and accounts of its comparative performances. I can then judge whether it is sufficiently promising to build a full sized machine.

I have done no experimenting for over a year. I found last year that my business was in danger, and my resources threatened.
